


january

In February we took a much needed vacation to sunny Florida. We took on Walt Disney World and enjoyed every second.






In March Coulter took a solo trip to BC for a quick visit with some old friends.
















But before we left, we celerbated with our friends Andy and Katie, as they announced the gender of heir new daughter, Maeve!




On our trip to the Evergreen state, we hit up the classic stops: Fred Meyer, Hobby Lobby, and Macy's. Every Canadian's shopping dream.

Afer our trip was done, we flew home with Spencer to enjoy some bro-time at our place.






july joys

august






We also got a BBQ for free on the side of the road! So we enjoyed well grilled meats for the rest of the season.

As part of working for a Toronto company, Sydney took a solo trip to Toronto for some business planning. But spent lots of time having fun with her new co-workers.




october
